Digital data storage and use in the MBA Alumni Network of the MBA Programme “CSR & NGO Management” at Bonn-Rhein-Sieg University on the basis of the European General Data Protection Regulation

(en.: EU- GDPR; dt.: EU-DSGVO)

From 25 May 2018, the new European General Data Protection Regulation (EU-GDPR) applies directly to all Member States of the European Union and so is binding for the Bonn-Rhein-Sieg University and its departments. The University and the coordination office of the MBA Programme “CSR & NGO Management” stores personal data of former MBA students and members in a local alumni database exclusively for the following purposes:

- MBA alumni profiles on the website section “*Alumni of the MBA Programme*”
- specific alumni activities in the department of the MBA in CS & NGO Management Programme (especially information about updates within the MBA Programme and important university-wide events, special education offers for MBA alumni, internal events, alumni reunion events)
- promotion and invitation to the social media alumni groups and channels (with main focus on LinkedIn, Facebook and the centralized alumni department of the university)
- postings on the website section “*News & Updates*” and “*Alumni of the MBA Programme*”

The personal data of MBA alumni and other members of the MBA Programme can only be accessed by the responsible coordinators of the MBA Programme. The respective area manager is responsible for compliance according to the principles and must be able to prove their compliance. The data will only be stored in a database of the [MBA Coordination Office](#) and not be passed on to third parties. Appropriate technical and organisational measures must be taken to ensure that personal data are protected against unauthorised or unlawful processing, accidental loss, accidental destruction or damage. All the necessary measures have been taken at our university and the MBA coordination office on the basis of the existing legal situation to protect personal data and thus the personal rights of each person in order to ensure the highest possible level of data protection. The MBA coordination office refers furthermore to the “data privacy statement” of the Bonn-Rhein-Sieg University which is available online via:
