Students whose undergraduate degree (Article 3 paragraph 1) comprises fewer than 210 credits, but a minimum of 180 credits must complete the Practical Term module, which takes a minimum of 16 and a maximum of 27 weeks. At the end, a Practical Term Report must be submitted to earn 30 ECTS.
