

Part-Time Option:

Seminars of the MBA programme are scheduled Fridays and Saturdays only – with the exception of the “Welcome-Week” and “Intensive-Week” at the beginning of the 1st and 3rd semester respectively. As most MBA-students are fully employed with a busy schedule, studying during the weekends can be a challenging enterprise.

For that reason the MBA offers the part-time option in which the overall study time is expanded from 3 to 5 semesters.

As the programme is organized in modules, a part-time-student would study only half the modules offered each semester:
