

# **Terms of Use for the Online Storage Service (Bib-Cloud) provided by the Bonn-Rhein-Sieg University and District Library**

The online storage service (Bib-Cloud) provided by the Bonn-Rhein-Sieg University and District Library is available to all members of the library.

The terms of use for the online storage service are based on the Administration and Usage Rules (VBO) of the University and District Library.

## **Scope**

These terms of use shall apply to usage of the online storage service provided by the Bonn-Rhein-Sieg University and District Library. In using the service, the user expressly agrees to these terms of use, without any further declaration being necessary to this effect.

## **Online Storage Service (Bib-Cloud)**

The online storage service Bib-Cloud is based on the ownCloud open source software. Software development is coordinated by ownCloud, Inc.

Bib-Cloud is primarily a storage service, which is offered based on "as available", i. e. without engagement. Usage of Bib-Cloud requires additional access software on the user's personal device which is not provided by the University and District Library.

Access to the online storage service is composed of the library user number and the library password.

## **Access Code**

You are liable for any usage of the online storage offerings that is implemented with the aid of your access data (username and password). In particular, you are required to make sure that your password is protected from unauthorized use. In the event that you suspect or know about misuse of your access data, the library must be notified without delay. Users who make contents available to unauthorized third parties shall immediately forfeit their entitlement to use their library account and the services offered by the library.

## **Legal provisions on copyright**

The University and District Library provides you with the online storage service that is exclusively intended for private and academic use within the framework of the legal provisions on copyright. In accordance to the Administration and Usage Rules of the University and District Library, § 11(2) applies.

## **Making materials available in Bib-Cloud through users**

Users are liable for the materials they make available in Bib-Cloud (information, texts, software, images, videos, charts, audio and other materials). In particular, users are responsible for making sure that the documents do not contain any illegal contents or violate third-party rights (e.g. copyrights, personality rights).

## **Data Protection**

In accordance to the Administration and Usage Rules of the University and District Library, § 11(1) applies.

In accordance with the terms of use, you agree that your data is evaluated in anonymized form for academic purposes only.

## **Disclaimer**

In accordance to the Administration and Usage Rules of the University and District Library, § 12(5) applies.

In addition you expressly agree to use the online storage offerings at your sole risk. This also includes the risk of downloading data files that contain bugs and can harm your computer. You accept the sole liability for sufficient protection of your computer (e.g. by using virus scanners).

## **Termination of the entitlement to use Bib-Cloud**

The Bib-Cloud usage entitlement automatically expires on the date of de-registration from Bonn-Rhein-Sieg University and District Library. In accordance to the Administration and Usage Rules of the University and District Library, § 19 applies. Bonn-Rhein-Sieg University and District Library may restrict usage of and access to the Bib-Cloud offerings as well as the duration of and scope for usage at any time.
