Prof. Dr. Claudia Warning, who holds a doctorate in geography, has been teaching as Professor at the Bonn-Rhein-Sieg University of Applied Sciences since 2012 and previously as a lecturer for development cooperation at the International Centre for Sustainable Development of the University.

Since 2022 she has been President of Care Germany.

From 2018 to 2022, she was General Director at the Federal Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development (BMZ). There she was responsible for the Asia department; Southeastern and Eastern Europe; Middle East; Latin America; Civil society; Churches

From 2005 to 2018 she was Executive Director of Bread for the World in the Protestant Work for Diakonie and Development and its predecessor organization, the Protestant Development Service. Prof. Dr. Claudia Warning previously gained her development policy experience in various governmental and nongovernmental institutions. In addition to the Karl Kübel Foundation for Children and Family, of which she was Executive Director from 1999 to 2005, these include the German Commission for Justice and Peace, the Federal Ministry for Regional Planning, Building and Urban Development and the German Foundation for International Development (now GIZ).

From 2005 to 2009 she was also chairwoman of the Association of German Development NGOs (VENRO), of which she was a member of the board for eight years. In addition, she has assumed and continues to assume board or management responsibility in numerous development cooperation and education organizations.

Prof. Dr. Claudia Warning has published extensively on development policy topics.
